You are free to interpret the show title, *Persons of Interest*, as you wish and we look forward to seeing what you create!

Your piece(s) must be wired and able to hang on a wall and there are specific size limits detailed below.

Together Center's gallery space is open for visitors Monday-Friday 9am-5pm.

This is a juried show open only to NWCS members with current membership. The entry fee may be paid by credit card online via Entrythingy, or you can pay by check. Please read the entry fee section of the prospectus if you do not plan on paying through Entrythingy as extra steps are involved and you will need to contact the Shows Committee first.

NOTE: When submitting your entry and payment in Entrythingy, there is sometimes a delay while the entry is processed and it may seem like it didn't go through. We incur charges for refunds and for each form submittal. Rather than resubmitting, contact us!

## **Dates**

SHOW DATES: Friday, September 25, 2026 to Friday, January 8, 2027

SUBMISSION & PAYMENT DEADLINE: Sunday, August 30 by 9pm US Pacific

(POSTMARK DEADLINE for checks is Friday, August 14 - please read Entry Fee details)

NOTIFICATIONS: by Friday, September 4.

SHIPPED artwork must arrive by Monday, September 14.

DROP OFF: Friday, September 18, 2-4pm.

ARTIST RECEPTION & AWARDS PRESENTATION: Friday, September 25, 2-4pm.

PICK UP: Monday, January 11, 2-4pm.

## **Entry Fee**

\$25 for up to 3 entries. Please submit your pieces together. NWCS incurs a cost for each form submission. The fee is nonrefundable.

Pay online (no later than August 30, 2026). Entrythingy uses PayPal to process credit card payments. Note that you do not need to login with a PayPal account to pay by credit card.

If you are paying by check, you will need to contact the Shows committee (email [shows@nwcollagesociety.org](mailto:shows@nwcollagesociety.org)) BEFORE your entry can be completed because we will have to manually submit it. We will give you the address for mailing the check when you contact us.

## **Sales**

The Shows committee will connect interested purchasers directly to the artists. There will be no commission to NWCS or the venue. Works may be submitted as NFS (not for sale).

## **Artwork Requirements**

- Entries must be original, entirely created by the entrant, and not shown in a previous NWCS exhibit.
- All entries must be collage, defined as: an artistic composition made of various materials (e.g., paper, photographs, paint) glued onto the substrate
- Minimum size is 9 inches in the smallest dimension and maximum size is 24 inches in the longest dimension.
- Accepted work must have a hanging wire attached. Sawtooth hangers are not compatible with the hanging system and we cannot display pieces that are not install-ready.
- Identify your artwork on the back with name, title, and price. There are labels on the last page of the prospectus for convenience.

NWCS reserves the right not to accept artwork they determine to be inappropriate. An example of art that might not be appropriate would be something that could be construed as a racial slur.

Digital images of accepted work will be retained by the NWCS and may be used for show promotion.

## **Submissions**

Images

- JPG or PNG only
- Minimum size on the shortest side: 1080px
- Maximum file size: 4mb
- Minimum file size: 500k
- If possible, please organize your file names in this format:  
    Lastname\_firstname\_title\_wxh.jpg  
    (brown\_john\_nightoverseattle\_24x24.jpg)

For the show booklet:

In the entry field, feel free to talk about your approach and interpretation of the show theme. Give a little background about you as an artist. Please do not submit CVs or long bios. A concise paragraph or two will do.

NWCS may use this information in promotional materials for the show, such as show booklets and social media posts.

## **Delivery/Shipping**

Shipped works must arrive by September 14. The Seattle-area delivery address will be provided in acceptance notifications.

Artists are responsible for roundtrip shipping and insurance (during shipping), and must include a return shipping label or arrangements for someone to pick up the work if not sold.

Please use a container appropriate for reuse in return shipping (boxes are preferred over padded envelopes), and make sure your name is clearly visible on the outside of the package.

Returned artwork will ship within 3 weeks of the show close.

**Awards**

There are up to 9 awards given for the fall show, presented with a certificate and a check at the reception. NWCS relies on the juror to determine criteria for distinction between the two tiers of awards.

Second tier: up to 4 Merit Awards
