Entrants must be current NWCS members in good standing.

Every artist is responsible for reading and complying with the info below.

- Member fee: Non-refundable entry fee is \$25 for one-to-three entries. Pay online (no later than 2/7/23). Pay by check (postmark by 2/7/23) made payable to Northwest Collage Society. Send checks to John Arbuckle, 4309 226th Pl. SW, Mountlake Terrace WA 98043.
- 2. All work must be for sale. The Fogue Gallery shall remit to the artist the net proceeds from the sale, less 30% and applicable sales tax within 30 days after closing of exhibit.
- 3. Entries must be original, entirely created by the entrant, and not shown in a previous NWCS exhibit.
- 4. 2-D and 3-D collage artwork will be accepted.

- 5. All entries must be collage, defined as: an artistic composition made of various materials (e.g., paper, photographs, paint) glued onto a supporting surface.
- 6. Size restrictions: Maximum dimension 48 inches W/H. Minimum dimension 3x3 inches W/H. (Dimensions do not include the frame.) Weight not to exceed 12 lbs.
- 7. Plexiglass is required for all frames w/ glass measuring greater than 14" in any direction.
- 8. White, off-white or black mats only; no mats or frames required for wrap around canvas.
- All work must be hung with wire that is placed 1/3 of the way down from the top of the artwork, suspended between 2 eye-screws. No sawtooth hangers. If your work is not configured to accept wire hanging, please contact the Show Coordinators. Identify your artwork on the back with a label listing your name, title and price.
- 10. The Fogue Gallery reserves the right not to accept artwork they determine to be inappropriate. An example of art that might not be appropriate would be something that could be construed as a racial slur.
